Established in Southern California in January 2007, Kristen brought the Executive Women’s Summit home to Colorado in 2009. Women’s Summit Gatherings take place three times per year and were designed to address three primary "spheres" in a woman's life: Business, Social, and Philanthropic. To maintain exclusivity, participation is by-invitation only and limited to female executives at the Vice President level or above. In collaboration with the Women's Leadership Council and Mile High United Way, The Executive Women's Summit has co-created a scholarship fund for residents at the Brunetti Lofts, a transformational housing program supporting adult self-sufficiency. Kristen donates 10% of ticket sales to the Brunetti Seed Fund.

Upon departing a larger Retained Search firm based out of Southern California, Kristen was determined to build a more custom and client-focused approach to talent solutions. In 2009, Kristen co-founded a boutique executive recruiting firm and ultimately Founded Kenton Talent Management in 2010.
